32 Count – 4 Wall Intermediate Line Dance

Suggested songs: *Caliente* by Bayside Boys; Newer song: *Jai Ho!* by the Pussycat Dolls

Country alternatives: *All that Heaven will Allow* & *I Know You Want Me Too*, both by the Mavericks

Beats: Description

1-8 Pivot Right, Triple Forward LRL, Complete L Turn in 2 Counts, Triple Fwd

1,2 Step L forward; Pivot ½ turn to right, weight to R foot

3&4 Triple forward LRL

5,6 Step forward on R foot beginning turn to left; Complete turn on ball of R, stepping forward on L (or walk forward R, L)

7&8 Triple forward RLR (8 counts end facing 6:00)

9-16 Mambo Left with ½ turn left: Mambo with Right; Repeat

1&2 Step L foot to L side; Step R foot in place while turning ½ to left (&); Step L foot next to R (almost like a Monterey turn to left, but with a rock instead of point);

3&4 Step R foot to R side; Step L foot in place (&); Step Right next to L;

5&6 Repeat 1&2

7&8 Repeat 3&4

(easier variation of 1&2 and 5&6: don't turn the Mambo, just do in place)

17-24 Cross Left in Front of R , R Step Side, L Sailor Step;

Cross Right in Front of L, L Step Side, R Sailor Step.

1,2 Cross L foot in front of R; R step to right side;

3&4 Cross L foot behind R; R step to right side (&); Step L foot to left side;

5,6 Cross R foot in front of L; L step to left side;

7&8 Cross R foot behind L; L step to left side (&); Step R foot to right side.

25-32 Cross, Hold, Step R, Hip Rocks Left-Right; L Sailor Step; R Coaster Step with ¼ turn Right (end facing 9:00)

1,2 Cross L foot in front of right; Hold;

&3,4 Step R foot to right side (&); Step L foot to left side as hips sway left (3); Sway hips to right (4);

5&6 Cross L foot behind R; Step R foot to right side (&); Step L foot to left side;

7&8 Swing R foot back into ¼ turn to the right; Step Ball of L next to R (&); Step R foot forward. (You can think of the R Coaster Step, as R Sailor Step with a ¼ turn - the timing is the same, and the footwork between a ¼ turn Coaster or Sailor is almost indistinguishable, especially at fast speeds :-)
