Wednesday: Line Dance Lessons and Dancing all evening to DJ Dwight!

- \$5.00 Cover Charge for all dancers includes the lessons.
- Doors open at 7:00 PM, at the Crown Lounge entrance (follow the sidewalk to the left of the main entrance)
- Line Dance Lessons with Rose Haven and Debbie Scott, begin at about 7:30 for an hour.
- Line Dances taught vary from easy (1st dance taught for the new dancers) to intermediate level for the experienced dancers. All dances are usually taught & reviewed for 3 weeks to optimize learning!
- After lessons, we continue to dance to a variety of Country songs, rock, pop, etc. and to various rhythm music (two-step, cha, swing, hustle etc)!
- After Wednesday night lessons, I lead easy to follow dances on the dance floor, close to the stage (including the easy dances taught that night at lessons)... so that all new dancers can keep on dancing!
- There's plenty of room on our large dance floor to accommodate couples, partner, freestyle, and several different line dances. Come on out and join the fun – meet new friends and dance, dance, dance!
- We often have live bands in the Crown Lounge on Wednesdays too! See Wild Bill's Website for more information: www.wildbillsatlanta.com
- We keep a "Song Request Sheet" on the round table closest to the stage on the left when you're facing the stage. List 1 or 2 of your favorite dance songs from our DJ. If it is a song for an old line dance, please be prepared to help lead the dance when the song come on by going on the floor and starting the dance at the right time.
- At the bottom of the Email Sign-up sheet, next to the Song Request Sheet, you can request dances you'd like reviewed at Wednesday lessons in coming weeks.

Come out and dance & party some more on Fridays & Saturday's at Wild Bill's on DJ nights or concerts. BUT please first check Wild Bill's Website first or my weekly emails – Concert nights usually require purchased tickets or may have a slightly higher cover charge and there is an occasional "Fight Night" on Fridays or Saturdays. So know what's going on if you plan to come out!

<u>Dance Floor Etiquette:</u> Please note that the middle of the dance floor is for line dancers (2 or 3 at the same time). The outside edge of the floor is reserved for couples dances like Two-Step, Swing, Cha Cha, etc. Please refrain from standing on the edges of the dance floor or line dancing to the outer edge, so that couples dancers can use that space.

<u>Dancer's Tubes for shoes:</u> I have a supply of the tubes that are placed over shoes to improve a smooth feel on the dance floor. Please ask me about it if you're in need of these. These work fine with athletic shoes, or appropriate street shoes (shoes that are secure on your feet). Be sure to leave some of the sole on your shoes exposed, so your feet do not slip too much!
